Establishes the religious freedom restoration act. Prohibits the State and its political subdivisions to substantially burden a person's exercise of religion even if the burden results from a general applicability unless the State or political subdivisions demonstrates the burden furthers a compelling government interest and is the least restrictive means of furthering that compelling interest. -- Establishes provisions relating to licensing and certification of domestic relations contracts under the department of health law. Provides that the rights obligations of marriage shall be granted to the licensees upon the solemnization of the marriage ceremony. Prohibits a marriage license to be denied to any couple solely because both applicants are of the same gender and establishes requisites of marriage license. Further establishes requisites of reciprocal beneficiary certificate. Requires the department of health to issue reciprocal beneficiary certificates to applicants who are legally prohibited from obtaining a marriage license and have

Establishes provisions relating to continuity of rights; civil union and reciprocal beneficiary relationships. Allows 2 individuals who are civil union partners or reciprocal beneficiaries with each other, to marry each without 1st terminating their civil union or reciprocal beneficiary relationship. Provides that the rights, benefits, protections, and responsibilities created by the civil union or reciprocal beneficiary relationship shall be continuous through the marriage and deemed to have accrued as of the 1st date these rights existed under the civil union or reciprocal beneficiary relationship. Requires that when necessary to implement the rights, benefits, protections and responsibilities of spouses under the laws of this State, all gender specific terminology such as "husband", "wife", "widow", "widower", or similar terms be construed in a gender neutral manner. Does not require any clergy, minister, priest, rabbi, officer of any religious denomination or society, or religious society that is authorized to perform solemnizations to solemnize marriage that is in violation of their religious belief or faith. Prohibits a person who fails or refuses to solemnize any marriage to be subject to any fine, penalty, injunction, administrative proceeding, or any other legal or administrative liability for the failure or refusal. Prohibits a religious organization to be subject to any fine, penalty, injunction, administrative proceeding or any other legal or administrative liability for refusing to provide goods, services, or its facilities or grounds for solemnization or celebration of a marriage that is in violation of its religious beliefs or faith. -- Authorizes the department of health to make any changes necessary to internal procedures or forms. -- SB0001 2SP HD1
